

CABINET CARE

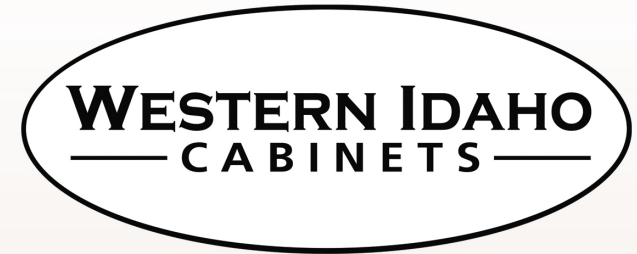
Your cabinets are like a fine piece of furniture and need to be cared for in a similar manner. Most people would not consider setting a glass of water on their beautiful furniture, but do not give their cabinets the same consideration. For some reason there is a lack of understanding that kitchen cabinetry is very similar to a fine piece of furniture and needs the same type of care. Water is one of the worst enemies to the finish on your cabinetry. It is pretty simple to keep the water off of your fine furniture, but it can be a different story with your cabinetry. We want to offer some advice to help care for and to maintain your beautiful cabinetry and keep it looking like the day you moved in.

1. To polish and dust your cabinets, we recommend **“Magic Cabinet & Wood Cleaner”**. We do not recommend any other product to care for your cabinets. These products may affect any touch up procedures which will more than likely involve applying a new coat of lacquer. Lacquer reacts with many of the furniture polishes on the market today when applied over the top of these products. Applying lacquer over the top of certain furniture polishes or cleaners will cause the finish to wrinkle and fish eye. If you need a more aggressive product than Magic Cabinet & Wood Cleaner to clean with, use a soft scrub cleanser, then use Cabinet Magic to polish and clean any cleanser residue off. **NEVER USE WATER TO CLEAN OR WIPE DOWN YOUR CABINETS.**



2. **Avoid** draping damp or wet towels or rags over the doors. This will cause water damage.
3. **Never** use a cleaner or cleanser that has abrasive in it. This will scratch your cabinetry.
4. If your kitchen has glass doors, spray a small amount of glass cleaner on a rag and then clean your glass. Do not spray the glass cleaner directly onto the glass door because it might get some on the wood frame and will cause damage to your finish.
